

## DAILY UPDATE

### Cox's Bazar

- Three temporary quarantine centers, each having 100 rooms in it, have been set up in Cox's Bazar by the district administration. They also started selling daily necessary goods at a cheaper rate through Trading Corporation of Bangladesh (TCB).
- The Cox's Bazar district police made public announcements and disseminated leaflets among the drivers of public transports. They also asked the authority to keep handwashing soap and water at every bus stop for the passengers.

### Host community and camps

- Requested by UNHCR, 'Shelter, Food and NFI' of HCMP started preparing the repatriation centre as an isolation centre. They are also set to build six refugee housing units and 8,000 meter fence around the repatriation centre within five days.
- WASH team conducted hygiene awareness sessions at the households today in 12 camps, reaching 3,153 people. A total of 1,233 latrines, 770 bathing cubicles and 127 tap stands in several of camps have been cleaned today by the WASH team.
- A total of 604 handwashing stations have been installed today in 12 camps.
- A total of 727 tippy taps have been installed today in the households of assigned camps.
- A 6,414 feet long drain has been cleaned by the WASH team in the camps today.
- The WASH team is conveying key messages endorsed by the civil surgeon in the Rohingya communities of the refugee camps.
- HCMP volunteers are using a mic system to spread the message of washing hands every time someone touches something.
- A total of 5,913 households have been visited by the health sector. Among them, 1,201 are from the FDMN community and 4,712 are from the host community.
- Message on COVID-19 delivered to 23,875 people by the health sector. Among them, 4,855 are from the FDMN community and 19,020 are from the host community.

### Humanitarian Crisis Management Programme

- Any staff opting to move to their home during the general holidays are requested to stay at their current locations, considering the health priority and to limit the spread of COVID-19.
- All staff are strictly requested to wash their hands properly before entering into their offices and cooperate with the security personnel in this regard. Employees are also asked to maintain proper social distance during any gathering.
- HCMP health sector is conducting training sessions for the site management sector's volunteers on preventing the spread of Covid-19. They are training 10 volunteers a session, with an aim to train 100 volunteers per camp in four days.
- Proper mental counselling support will be provided for any staff overwhelmed by the COVID-19 outbreak.
- The allocated budget from IOM is revised in order to hire 100 more volunteers and procure more personal protective equipment.
